Seven reasons to ski at newly renovated Wilmot Mountain:

- NEW TERRAIN PARKS. With a new high-speed rope tow, freestyle skiers and snowboarders can spend more time on the slopes and let the snow fly! Green, blue and black runs—all lit for nighttime sking—are groomed every night.
- instruction. An expanded ski and snowboard school offers rental equipment for all ages and abilities. Instructors are certified by PSIA (Professional Ski Instructors of America), meaning they have the highest standards and quality teaching skills.
- BETTER SNOW QUALITY. State-of-the-art snowmaking guns shoot water into the air to make man-made snow more powdery, not icy.
 MAIN LODGE. The renovation shows off a pitched, pine-beam ceiling, giving the building a ski lodge feeling. The food court
